Last year *SchoolsRule* distributed \$482,000 to Marin's public schools, which by the way happens to include 35,655 students. The funds were earmarked for four key initiatives: literacy, technology, health and the arts. This means that the Lagunitas School District can pay for district-wide assemblies to engage their students with performing arts. It means that the Novato Unified School District can fund library materials and technology grants at 13 different school libraries. That San Rafael

Elementary and High School Districts can keep supporting their programs for orchestra, jazz, chorus, steel pans and marching band. It means all of this and so much more for all the kids of Marin schools. And there are more stories just like these for every single district in Marin. Let's all take a moment to celebrate this huge success.
